

## u-blox general RoHS declaration of conformity

Dear Valued Customer,

The **Restriction of the use of certain Hazardous Substances (RoHS) Directive 2002/95/EC** first took effect in July 2006. In July 2011 the Directive 2011/65/EU, sometimes referred to as RoHS 2, was published in the Official Journal by the European Commission.

Among the changes registered with the RoHS 2, the most important states that the CE marking, i.e., the conformity marking applicable for products at European Union level, should also apply to any electrical and electronic equipment (EEE) that is subject to the RoHS directive. No change was registered in terms of restriction limits (threshold) applicable to the six hazardous substances, per homogenous material (Lead, Mercury, Cadmium, Hexavalent chromium, PBB, and PBDE).

On June 2015, Directive 2011/65/EU was amended by Directive 2015/863/EU (RoHS 3) to add four new phthalates, Bis(2-ethylhexyl)phthalate (DEHP), Benzyl butyl phthalate (BBP), Dibutyl phthalate (DBP) and Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP). This increases the total number of restricted substances to 10. European Union member states began to apply the adopted provisions in July 2019. To the best of our knowledge as of today and with information provided by our suppliers, u-blox's volume products that have reached Initial Production status comply with the requirements of the Directive 2011/65/EU and Directive 2015/863/EU.
